



## Certification of Self Employment

The U.S. Army requires that the spouse/partner of the qualifying U.S. Army sponsor be employed a minimum of 16 hours per week in order to qualify for benefits under the U.S. Army Child Care Subsidy Program. As a self employed individual, the Certification Statement must be completed and signed by the sponsor and spouse/partner in order to qualify for fee assistance.
